

Durham County Council Air Quality Management Area (Chester le Street) (No.1) Order 2013

Environment Act 1995 Part IV Section 83 (1)

AQMA Order**

Durham County Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 83(1) of the Environment Act 1995, hereby makes the following Order.

This Order may be cited as the Durham County Council Air Quality Management Area (Chester le Street) (No.1) Order and shall come into effect on 17 May 2013.

The area demarcated in red on the attached map is to be designated as an air quality management area (the designated area). The designated area incorporates the road, pavements and properties detailed on the attached schedule, comprising of the row of terraced properties of Glen Terrace, both of which are situated on Pelton Fell Road to the west of Chester le Street town centre.

The designated area shall include any future dwellings in or adjacent to the area marked.

This Area is designated in relation to a likely breach of the nitrogen dioxide (annual mean) objective as specified in the Air Quality Regulations 2000 and Air Quality (Amendment) Regulations 2010 (SI 3043)

This Order shall remain in force until it is varied or revoked by a subsequent order.
