

The County Council of Durham
(Public Rights of Way Footpath No.44 Wolsingham Parish)
(Temporary Footpath Closure)
Order 2024

The Council on 19/8/2024 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on a section of Footpath No.44 Wolsingham parish from the junction with Footpath No.43 and extending southwards for a distance of 86 metres to safeguard members of the public from falling. An alternative route will be signed on site parallel to the closed section. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months and shall come into force on 20/8/2024 for a period of up to 6 months or until remedial works are undertaken. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
