

The County Council of Durham
(Aldwin Close, Skirlaw Close, Alington Close, Kirkham Close, Villiers Close and
Hambleton Way, Chilton)
(Temporary Road and Footpath Closure)
Order 2024

The Council on 6/9/2024 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit all vehicular and pedestrian traffic from proceeding on the following lengths of road and footpath **Road Closure (closed to vehicular traffic)** **1.** a 49 metre length of Aldwin Close between Number 11 and Numbers 1 to 5 and also a 53 metre length between Number 27 and Numbers 17 to 22 **2.** a 65 metre length of Skirlaw Close between Number 27 Granville Drive and Numbers 5 to 9 Skirlaw Close **3.** a 40 metre length of Alington Close between Number 1 and Numbers 4 to 7 **4.** a 68 metre length of Kirkham Close between Number 16 and Numbers 5 to 8 **5.** a 60 metre length of Villiers Close between Number 1 and Numbers 7 to 10 **Footpath Closure (closed to pedestrian traffic)** a 47 metre length of footpath of Hambleton Way from the side of Number 1 to rear Number 2 and side Number 6 to enable new fibre telecom infrastructure installation works to be undertaken. Alternative routes will not be available to vehicular traffic during the installs in the cul-de-sacs. Other footways and footpaths are available in the adjacent area during the footpath closure. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The proposed works are to commence on 17/9/2024 and are anticipated to be completed in 6 months. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
