

The County Council of Durham
(Beckstones Wath Footbridge and Public Right of Way Footpath No.5a and Public
Right of Way Footpath No.48 and Public Bridleway No.23, Eggleston to Mickleton)
(Temporary Footbridge, Footpath and Bridleway Closure)
Order 2024

The above-named Order made by the Council on 26/1/24, under section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and which became operational on 5/2/24 has been continued in force from 5/8/2024 with works anticipated during September 2024, as approved by the Secretary of State for Transport, until 2/2/2025 or completion of the works, whichever is the earlier. The effect of the Order is to prohibit all traffic from proceeding on the following lengths of footbridge, footpath or bridleway: **Temporary Footbridge Closure** It will be necessary to temporarily close to all traffic: Beckstones Wath Footbridge. **Temporary Footpath Closure** It will be necessary to temporarily close to pedestrian traffic: Public Footpath No.5a Mickleton Parish, and Public Footpath No.48 Eggleston Parish **Temporary Bridleway Closure** It will be necessary to temporarily close to all traffic: a 187 metre length of Public Bridleway No.23, Eggleston Parish between its junction with Public Bridleway No.24 and the access track to Ornella Farm, Eggleston to enable replacement of existing rotting timber bearers and deck treads works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be signed to traffic during the closure period.
