The County Council of Durham (Chaytor Road, Bridgehill, Consett) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2024

The Council on 13/9/2024 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended, Section 14 (1) to prohibit all vehicular traffic from proceeding on a 545 metre length of Chaytor Road between its junctions with Pemberton Road and Pleasant View, Bridgehill, Consett to enable carriageway resurfacing works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to vehicular traffic from the south eastern side of the closure north easterly on Pemberton Road then north westerly on A691 Cutlers Hall Road and then generally westerly from Hardys Corner onto Pleasant View to the north western side of the closure and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are to commence from 7am on Wednesday 25/9/2024 and are anticipated to be completed in a 9 day period (there will be no closures implemented over the weekend). On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
