The County Council of Durham (Public Footpath No. 53, White Kirkley Footbridge, Frosterley) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2024

The Council on 09/09/2024 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Section 14(1) to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on a 17 metre length of Footpath No. 53 Stanhope Parish at White Kirkley Footbridge south of Frosterley due to an unsafe footbridge and to enable repair works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to pedestrian traffic from the western side of the closure from Footpath No. 12 near Pye Close / Fineburn via Footpath No's. 12 and 13, extending north easterly to Low Bishopley and south to White Kirkley leading to the eastern side of the closure, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The works are expected to commence on 11/9/2024 for a period of 6 months or until the footbridge is safe to re-open, whichever is the sooner. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
