The County Council of Durham (Footpath between A691 Southfield Way and Old Dryburn Way, Durham) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2024

The Council on 13/9/2024 made the above Order Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on an 88 metre length of footpath from its two accesses onto Old Dryburn Way (between numbers 12-24) and linking through to A691 Southfield Way, Durham to enable electricity supply upgrade works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to pedestrian traffic from the western side of the closure from via the footway of A691 Southfield Way and either the footpath link to Old Dryburn Way to the southeast or via the associated footway from the Hospital Roundabout leading to Old Dryburn Way leading to the eastern side of the closure, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The works are expected to commence on Monday 23/9/2024 however are likely to be delayed until 21/10/2024. They are anticipated to be completed in 2 weeks. On occasions, alternative dates for closure may be necessary and these will be signed accordingly.
