

The County Council of Durham
(Laurel Court, Lilac Court, Spruce Court and Aspen Court, Shildon)
(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2022

The above-named Order made by the Council on 5/8/2022, under section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and which became operational on 15/8/22 and was subsequently extended to 31/10/2024 has been continued in force from 31/10/2024, as approved by the Secretary of State for Transport, until 31/3/2025 or until completion of the works, whichever is the earlier. The effect of the Order is to temporarily prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on the following lengths of footpath in Shildon: **A. Phases 1-3** 1. A 65 metre length between numbers 1- 10 Laurel Court 2. An 84 metre length of footpath from the side of number 22 Spruce Court that extend northwards to the western footpath junction with the associated footway of Spruce Court Cross 3. A 45 metre length of footpath that extends from the side of number 12 Lilac Court to its intersection with the footpath in 2. above **B. Phase 1** 1. A 167 metre length of segregated footpath that extends westward from Hilsdon Drive along the northern side of Aspen Court and Laurel Court 2. A 56 metre length footpath that extends westward from Hilsdon Road along to the south of, and to the junction with Aspen Court 3. A 20 metre length of footpath that extends westward from the path detailed in A.1. to the south of and to the junction with Laurel Court **C. Phase 2** 1. A 20 metre length of footpath that extends westward from Hilsdon Drive along the northern side of and to the junction with Lilac Court 2. A 55 metre length of associated footway of Spruce Court Cross along the northern side of and between the junctions of Lilac Court and Spruce Court 3. A 67 metre length of associated footway of Spruce Court Cross that extends along the northern side of, and westward from the junction with Spruce Court **D. Phase 3** 1. A 140 metre length of footpath that extends along the westernmost perimeter of the site between the north western footpath adjacent to number 18 Laurel Court to the footpath south of number 14 Spruce Court 2. A 148 metre length of footpath that extends south westerly adjacent to 18-24 Laurel Court, continuing south easterly to 7 Spruce Court and then south westerly to number 14 Spruce Court to enable highway upgrade works to be undertaken. Alternative routes will be available to pedestrian traffic via other footpaths and footways throughout the site Date: 9/2/24 Helen Bradley Head of Legal & Democratic Service.
