

**The County Council of Durham
(Bail Hill Road, Mickleton)
(Temporary 3 Tonne Weight Restriction)
Order 2024**

The Council on 20/12/2024 made the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to prohibit vehicular traffic, exceeding a maximum gross weight of 3 tonnes, from proceeding on the following length of road. A 45 metre length of Bail Hill Road that passes over Bail Hill (Banklands Quarry) Bridge, between the field accesses to the northern (Teesdale Gun Club) and southern side of the bridge, south of Mickleton until bridge strengthening repairs are completed. An alternative route will be available to vehicular traffic (over 3 tonnes) from the northern side of the restriction, from Mickleton via the B6277, south easterly to Romaldkirk, then westerly via Fell Lane, to the southern side of the restriction, and vice versa. The order comes into force on 26/12/2024 for the duration of the works until completed.
