The County Council of Durham (Public Rights of way, Footpath Number 76, Crook Footbridge, Hunwick) (Temporary Public Footpath/Footbridge Closure) Order 2024

The Council on 20/12/2024 made the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on the following length of footpath. A 830 metre length of Footpath Number 76 Crook Parish, that crosses the Hunwick Footbridge between its junctions with Footpath 75 and Bridleway 79 in the south and Footpath 86 in the north, Hunwick to enable remedial works owing to an unsafe footbridge to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to pedestrian traffic from the southern side of the closure, from Footpath 76 north easterly and easterly on Footpath 75, to the junction with Footpath 76, near Farnley Farm/Meadow End leading south westerly to the northern side of the closure, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The works have already commenced and will continue from Thursday 26/12/2024 and are anticipated to be completed in 6 months, or until the footbridge is safe to re-open, whichever is the sooner. On occasions, alternative dates for the closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
