Reasons

In reaching its findings the Committee took into account the report of the Inspector and the evidence submitted in support of the application, and decided that on balance the statutory test for registration of the Application Land as Town or Village Green had been met by the applicant. The Committee was satisfied that:

- The Application Land has been used continually during the relevant 20 year period
- There has been significant usage of the Application Land for recreational purposes.
